Mission Statement

The mission of the Aaron Community Cultural Center is to provide education, social skills, employment training, and family system programs from birth to death. This mission will occur face to face and in a cyber environment.

Emergency Housings

ACCC programs are designed to simultaneously address several core issues facing low-income communities with housing, education, employment, crime prevention, leadership development, economic literacy, vocational skills, self-confidence, nutritional awareness, self-care, social and spiritual growth, stability, and self-reliance. Each participant will need to be enrolled in an educational program, work a minimum of 20 hours per week and volunteer a minimum of 3 hours per week at Aaron Community Cultural Center.

Aaron Community Cultural Center Emergency Housing Program has a limited number of beds. Individuals who want to participate in this program start with STEP ONE; completing an online application, filing out an essay, submitting volunteer schedule with available hours. In addition to the housing application, a volunteer application with skills needs to be submitted with the housing application. STEP TWO is a phone interview and STEP THREE is a face to face interview. STEP FOUR is a thank you letter with your status for the program.

The housing program serves as a transformational living interchange to help individuals transform their lives and find permanent housing and work on their desired careers. Tenants have responsibilities in daily check-ins, weekly cleaning schedules, and monthly meetings. Residents are required to work a minimum of 20 hours a week; otherwise, occupants are required to be in a vocational or college program.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- Applicants are required to have proof of residency (an I.D. Card or Driver's License), as well as, a social security card present during the face-to-face interview.
- Applicants are required to bring proof of work or income (latest paystub or GR approval and GR Housing Assistance application or other housing assistance approval and/or application).
- Applicants, if applicable, are required to show proof of an educational program (Student I.D.), as well as, a printed class schedule.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Housing recipients are required to volunteer time to the nonprofit. Those who do not wish to give back to the community will not qualify for ACCC's housing program.
- If a participant wishes to renew, he/she must apply online before renewal, otherwise, the spot may be filled by another person wishing to be housed in the program.
- Housing recipients are required to check-in and check-out daily. Those who do not follow this rule will no longer qualify to reside at ACCC.
- Housing recipients are required to participate in the ACCC Transformational Living program, which allows participants to report progress in moving forward to his/her goals.
- Housing recipients are required to work 20 hours a week or be in a college/education program. Those in an educational program are required to have income to pay for housing whether that be work in addition to school or General Relief assistance.

***** IMPORTANT *****

All payment is due before a contract/agreement can be signed or renewed.
If a contract/agreement is not signed, participant may be urged to leave premises immediately.
